

Project Intervention Logic Priority Axis 1:










In this presentation, we are going to give you an example of the project intervention logic applied to the Priority Axis 1 of our Programme.





The intervention logic of your project has to be designed in a way that it contributes directly to the achievement of the specific objective of the selected Priority Axis of the Programme.












On the next couple of slides, we are going to present how the PROGRAMME and PROJECT intervention logic are interrelated. An example of a project which may be applied to the Priority Axis 1 will be presented.





We are going to present 1.) how the main elements of the PROJECT intervention logic (activities, deliverables, outputs, specific objective(s), results, main objective) are related to the main elements of the PROGRAMME intervention logic, and 2.) how they are related among themselves.



Project activities Example: A.1.) Networking cross-border **Direct link** activities A.2.) Training activities for health/social workers in crossboreder area A.3.) Health and social services implementation in cross-border rural areas

- 3.) 500 persons from rural areas covered by health/social service


