Main outcome of a thematic workpackage (workpackages Implementation and Investment).

It should be captured by a programme output indicator, and directly contribute to the result.

achievement of the project

It can be tangible: like a device or a product, or intangible: like a service, capacity or skills

Min. I output per thematic work package.

Must be measurable



Project deliverable is a side-product or service of the project activity that contributes to the development of a project's outputs.

Reflecting the product of single activity or their intermediary steps.

Contributing to the achievement of project outputs.

Tangible and measurable item to be delivered as part of implementing activities.

One or more deliverables per activity.
