



The Role of Objectives in Project Intervention Logic



Important to know!



In the 2014-2020 financial perspective, all EU programmes are applying the result-oriented intervention logic.

Therefore, intervention logic of all the projects funded by our Programme has to be perfectly in line with the intervention logic of the Programme!

Intervention logic = the way on which a project or a Programme achieves its own objectives.



Intervention logic of your project has to be designed in a way that it contributes directly to the achievement of the specific objective of the selected Priority Axis of the Programme.

Or, to put it simply: you have to connect your project directly and concretely to the objectives of the Programme!



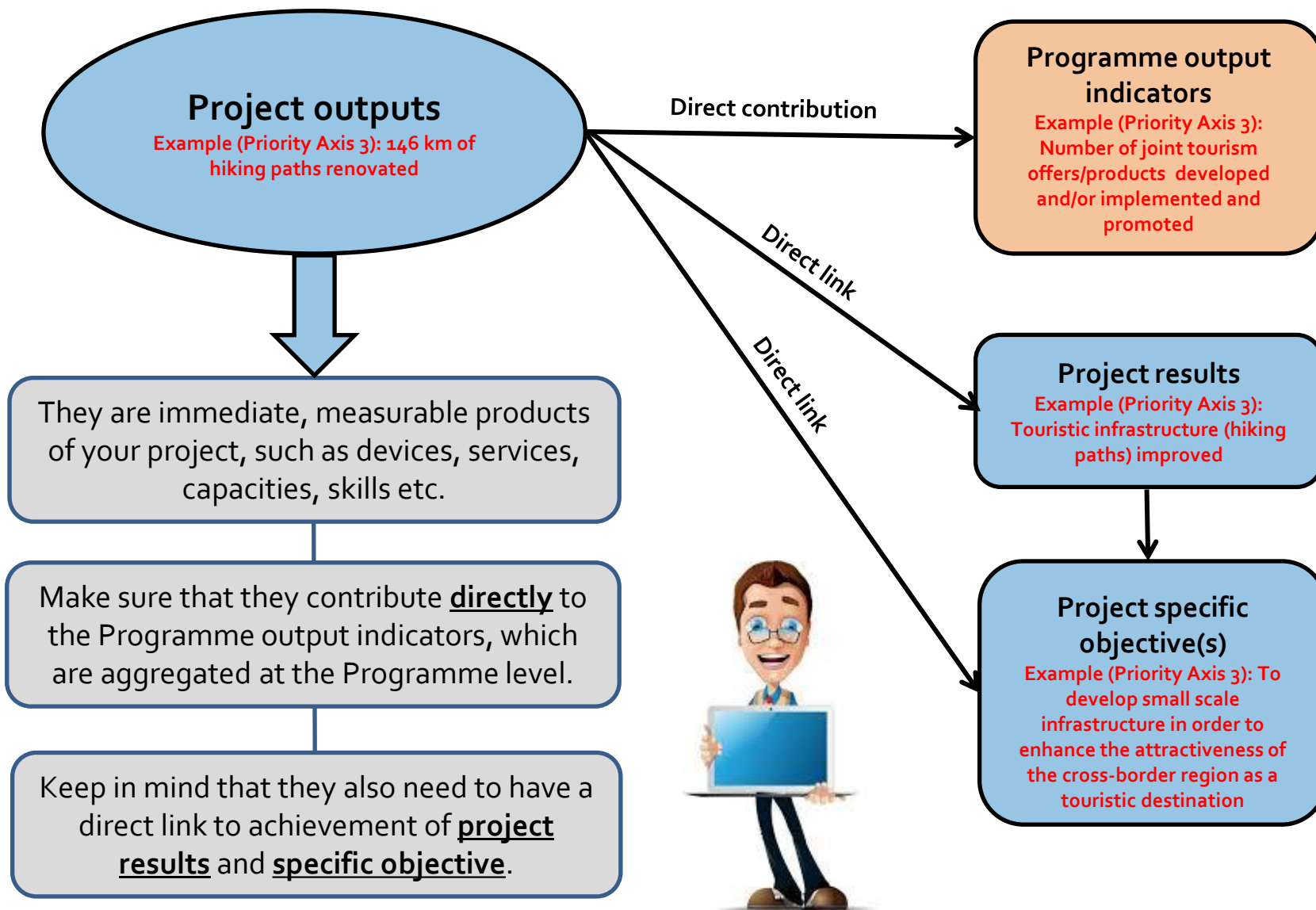


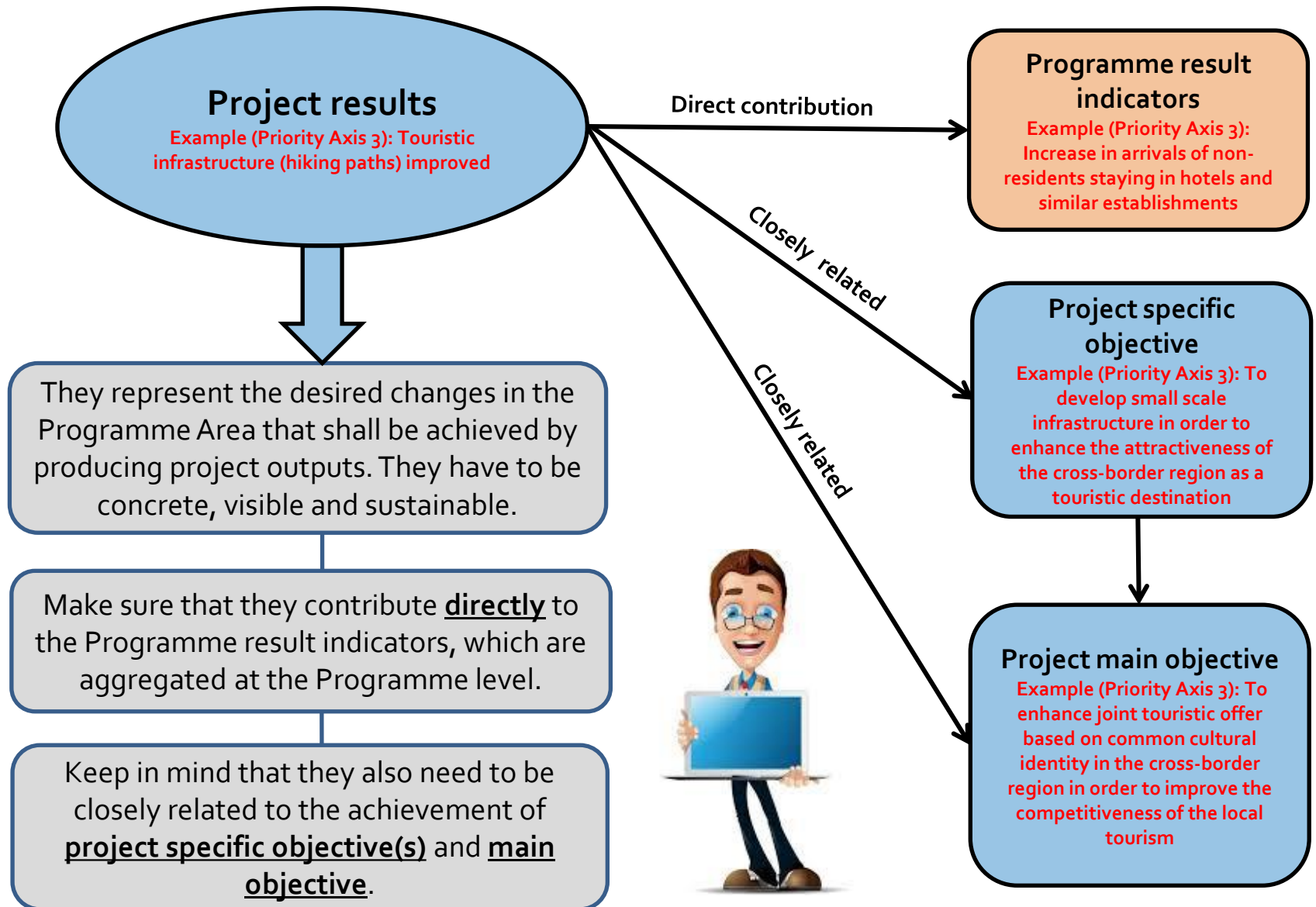
The objectives that you set for your project represent the concrete change you want to achieve in the Programme Area.

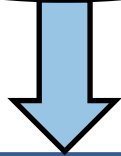
Therefore, all other elements of your project intervention logic have to support the achievement of objectives of your project as well as the objectives of the Programme.



So let us take a closer look at how particular elements of the project intervention logic relate to the project and Programme objectives...







They represent the change that the project will achieve in the Programme Area by the end of its implementation.

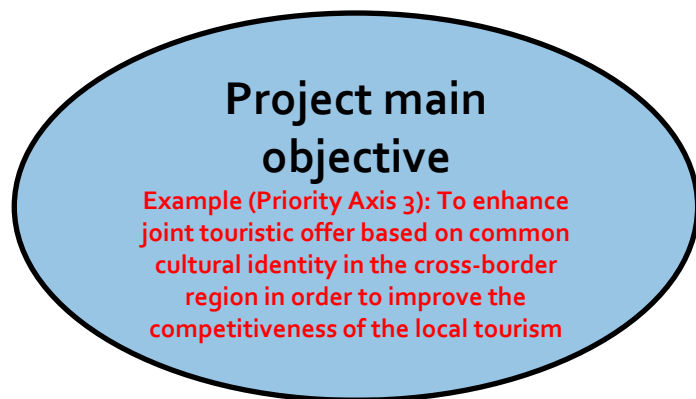
Make sure that they contribute **directly** to the specific objective of the selected Priority Axis of the Programme.

Keep in mind that they also need to contribute directly to the achievement of **the main objective of the project.**

Programme Priority Axis' specific objective

Example (Priority Axis 3): To strengthen and diversify the tourism offer through cross border approaches and to enable better management and sustainable use of cultural and natural heritage.

It represents the change that your project will achieve in the Programme Area in the long run.

Make sure that it contributes **directly** to the achievement of the specific objective of the selected Priority Axis of the Programme.
