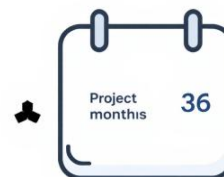

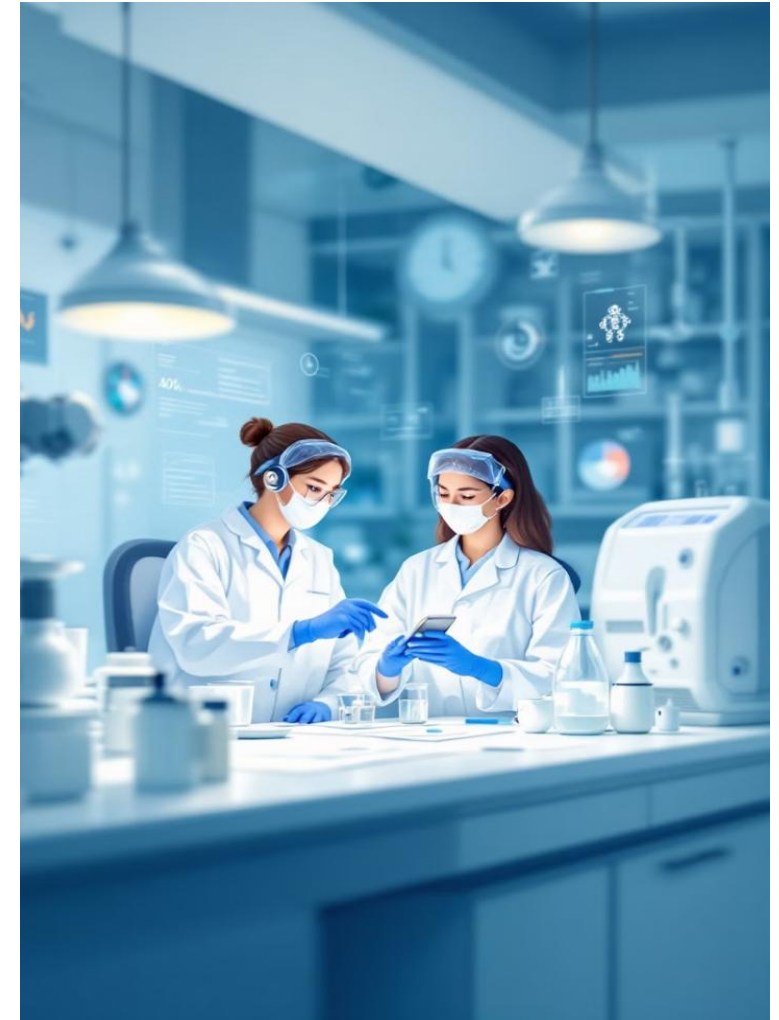

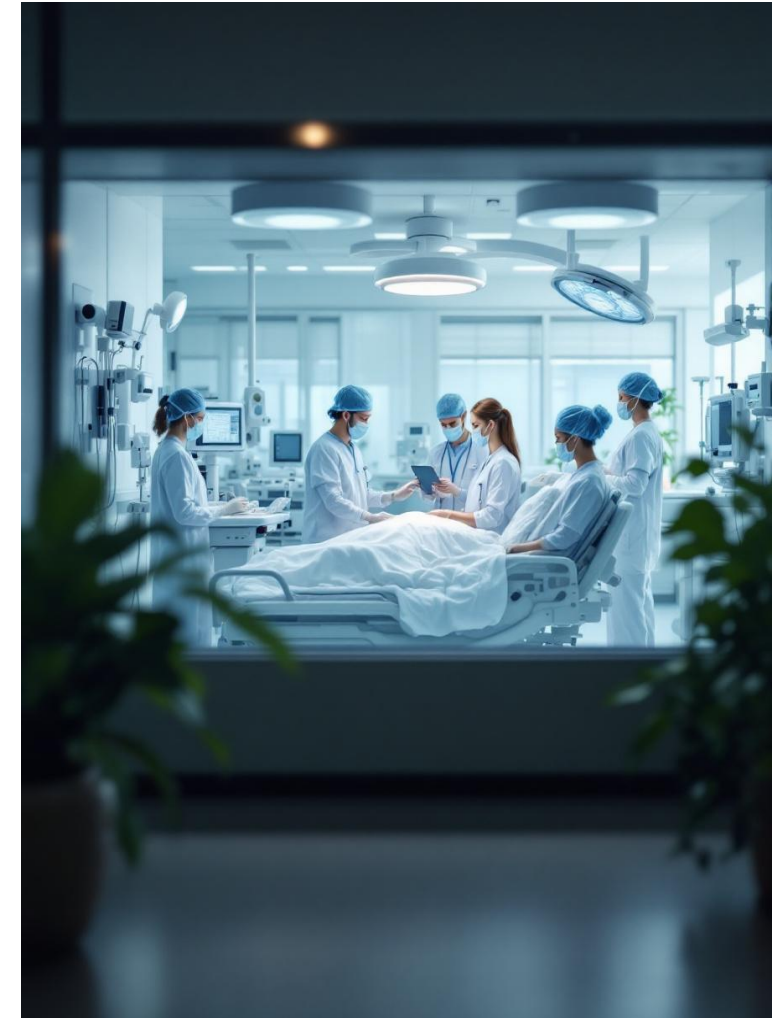
WP1: Oncology - Lung Cancer Prevention & Treatment

- 1** Early Lung Cancer Detection:
 - Mobile X-ray units with AI for screening in rural areas.
 - Digital solutions for patient risk assessment (React mobile app).
 - Secondary prevention program based on Croatia's model.
- 2** Radiotherapy & Treatment Enhancement:
 - Advanced radiotherapy equipment (stereotactic, brachytherapy).
 - Train medical professionals in modern radiotherapy techniques.
 - Implement AI-enhanced diagnostics for more precise treatment.
- 3** Public Health Initiatives:
 - Smoking cessation campaigns and public health events
 - Establishing a Cross-Border Oncology Council



WP2: Cardiology – Valvular Heart Disease & Hereditary Cancer

- 1** Standardized Patient Pathway for VHD:
 - Develop joint procedures for diagnosing and treating VHD.
 - Pilot actions for screening, diagnosis, and treatment of patients.
 - Equip hospitals with modern cardiology ultrasound devices.
- 2** Hereditary Cancer Risk & Genetic Testing:
 - Joint procedures for genetic screening of hereditary cancer risks.
 - Implement genetic counseling via telemedicine.
 - Network of laboratories for genetic testing in regional hospitals
- 3** Capacity Building & Medical Training
 - Joint certified training for cardiologists & oncologists
 - Specialized workshops, study visits, & networking events
